- ✓ Previous experience assisting in early learning and care environments or working directly with children
- ✓ Demonstrate understanding of licensed group care environment
- ✓ Knowledge of Indigenous culture and traditions
- ✓ Knowledge of and sensitivity to the needs of indigenous children and families
- ✓ Proven ability to work closely with other team members
- ✓ Sensitivity and respect for individual and cultural differences
- ✓ Adequate energy level and ability to meet the physical demands of the job
- ✓ Strong verbal and written communication skills, Indigenous language is an asset
- ✓ Early Childhood Education diploma or degree from a recognized college or university or equivalent education
